FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear Parishioners,

INSTITUTION OF ACOLYTE FOR CARMINE MORELLI

It is with great pleasure to announce that his Excellency Archbishop J. Michael Miller, will be in our Parish on Sunday, February 28, 2016 at the 12:00 noon mass to officially install one of our parishioners, Carmine Morelli, to the Ministry of Acolyte.

Many of you may know, Carmine Morelli had hoped to be ordained as a Permanent Deacon. Unfortunately, a technical requirement of Church law made this impossible.

Mindful of Carmine's gifts and dedication, Archbishop Miller responded to this unexpected situation by inviting Carmine to be instituted as an "acolyte."

What exactly does this mean? An acolyte is permanently instituted for service at the altar and to assist the Priest and Deacon. It is his place principally to prepare the altar and the sacred vessels and, if necessary, to distribute the Eucharist to the faithful as an extraordinary minister. Instituted acolytes serve as lay ministers at funeral vigils and committals, communal celebrations of the Liturgy of the Hours, and devotional/prayer services. They may also perform the various lay blessings from the Book of Blessings using the prescribed forms. They also serve as sacristans and as extraordinary ministers of Holy Communion for the sick and homebound. They can assist priests and deacons during the Rites of Baptism and Matrimony in whatever ways deemed necessary by the celebrant.

An instituted acolyte may expose the Blessed Sacrament for public veneration. He may open the tabernacle and also, as required, place the ciborium on the altar or place the host in the monstrance. At the end of the period of adoration, he may replace the Blessed Sacrament in the tabernacle. He does not, however, give the blessing with the Sacrament. It is appropriate for instituted acolytes to assist in the instruction of other lay ministers such as extraordinary ministers of Holy Communion, altar servers, lectors, and sacristans.

Please keep this date in mind . . . the Mass with Archbishop J. M. Miller and the Institution of Acolyte for Carmine Morelli on February 28th at 12 noon Mass. A reception will follow and the Knights of Columbus will host a breakfast/brunch.

Come and be part of the Holy Cross community team, giving and showing Carmine and his family, our prayers and support on this joyous occasion.
