FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear Parishioners,

In March of this year, I mentioned that we are sponsoring a family from Pakistan. They are Catholics who fled persecution and possible death in their home country, because of Muslim Blasphemy laws, to Thailand where they have been waiting in a refugee camp. Recently, we received good news from Immigration Canada, that they will be arriving in Vancouver on June 19, 2019.

The next step in our project will be to collect furniture and household items. If you can, or would like to donate any of the below- mentioned items, please text or call Betty Chung at 604-726-1575, or email her at betty_chung@sfu.ca Please, ensure that these items are clean and in usable condition. We ask that you keep these items at your home, as we do not have the space in which to store them. A week before transportation is scheduled, Betty will contact you, asking to bring said items to Holy Cross Parish.

FURNITURE: Dining table, Dining room chairs (7), Double bed (1) Single beds (6), Double bed mattress, Single bed mattresses, Dressers, Couch and Living room chairs, Coffee table, Side tables, TV stand, Desks, Bookshelves, Bedside tables.

He worked for 9 years in Saudi Arabia as a painter, plumber and general handyman and is willing to give anything a go. His wife has been a stay-at-home mom, but is a trained seamstress.
